Sample Think Aloud for Mr Brown Can Moo Think Aloud Most of these lines just describe Mr Brown and what he can do Mr Brown can make wonderful sounds, and one of the sounds is just "like a cow" The sound words are "Moo Moo" Dr Seuss could have just said "He can go ...
